

General Booking Conditions [Revision #3] [Please READ and SIGN EACH PAGE]

Please read these Booking Conditions carefully as they incorporate the basis upon which bookings are accepted by West Forever/Live the Dream. West Forever is an organiser of tour packages, but not a transport, tour and event or accommodation provider. West Forever acts only as an agent for those service providers.

Personal Travel Insurance:

Personal Travel insurance is NOT included in the tour cost. Our tours require that you take out a good quality and comprehensive Personal Travel Insurance, a policy that covers motorcycle riders and pillions riding motorcycles 1000cc and above. The policy should cover you for loss, damage, illness, injury or other unexpected circumstances and include motorbike riding.

We require proof of Personal Travel Insurance for each traveller via Fax or Email prior to trip commencement.

Motorcycle Insurance:

The motorcycles rented to you for the tour are covered by varying policies [Depending on the tour] please familiarise yourselves with the included cover and options before you sign the contract. The policy is included in the tour cost, but an imprint of your personal credit card will be taken when you pick up the bike.

Rider Commitment:

The motorcycles used on our tours are large, heavy and complex vehicles. We ask that the rider acknowledge familiarity with bikes 1000cc and over and that the rider has a fair riding experience on large motorcycles and respect the difficult handling of the motorcycles during dense traffic, wet weather and while driving on minor roads. [These bikes are not allowed on unsealed roads]. WE DO ASK THAT YOU CHECK WITH YOUR DOCTOR (AS WELL AS YOUR PASSENGER) THAT YOU ARE IN a good physical condition as some of our tour can be physically challenging (i.e. riding 500 km in extreme heat)

Payment by Credit Card:

The prices shown are for payments by cash, Cheque or Direct Deposit.

An additional 2% Credit Card Service Fee will be applied to the dollar amount paid by credit card.

Changes in Prices and Itineraries:

All prices are in Australian dollars (except where noted). Prices are inclusive of taxes and charges that apply as at the date of publishing. Prices are provided as a guide only and may vary due to changes in currency fluctuations. Please check all prices and information before booking. Please note that the price of your holiday may change at any time up to 60 days before your departure.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

All prices and charges are inclusive of Australian GST where applicable.

Deposits and Final Payments

A deposit of 35% of tour cost is payable within 7 days of confirmation of your reservation *. You will be notified at the time of your reservation if any additional deposit requirements apply. Full payment for your holiday package is required at least 60 days prior to departure, or by sale end date or payment deadline specified in individual package conditions, whichever is the earliest. If for any reason your balance is not received by us by the due date, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled and to apply the appropriate cancellation charges. A deposit holds services requested but does not guarantee prices.

Late Bookings

Bookings made within 60 days of departure will only be accepted if full payment is received by West Forever at time of reservation.

Cancellations, alterations and refunds:

Cancellation; Up to 60 days before departure, fee is 35% of total tour cost

59 to 20 days before departure, fee is 55% of total cost

19 to 8 days before departure, fee is 80% of total tour cost

Less than 8 days or no show before departure, fee is 100% total tour cost

Alterations to your package which requires reissuing of documents may incur a fee of \$100 per booking in addition to any charges levied by hotels or ground operators. A document reissue means an alteration to an existing booking and not a transfer to another package when cancellation fees may apply.

Refunds:

To the extent permitted by law, no refund is available for cancellations after holiday package has commenced or in respect of any tours, accommodation, meals or any other services not utilised.

No Shows:

If you fail show at the start of the tour, any refund will be given for missed days, events, accommodation and vehicle rental.

Product Descriptions:

Descriptions featured are based on current international hotel guides and information provided by hotels and suppliers. Any facilities shown as included are subject to change at any time. The standard of accommodation and other services are based on various factors, which are generally accepted as indicative of a certain class, however, West Forever/Live the Dream do not guarantee the standard, class, or fitness for purpose of that accommodation or service.

Maps are shown for general information and may not necessarily reflect actual routings, locations or services provided. The undersigned/s will soon participate on a tour organised by Live the Dream with approximately 20 other passengers.

Live the Dream is responsible for booking hotel rooms, flights, motor bike hire, and for organising the tour. Live the Dream is not responsible for any road accidents. Live the Dream is not responsible for any occurrence due to climate, road conditions, animals or natural disasters. The participant is a 100% responsible for himself and his safety. The participant affirms to be capable of riding a bike of such a capacity and to be capable of riding in any type of conditions. The participant will have a medical examination prior to departure in order to confirm he/she will be physically capable of completing such a trip and to confirm he/she supports high temperatures, stressful situations, fatiguing rides as some of the stages can be equivalent to 400km or more!

The participant agrees to display group spirit and to follow the directives instructed by the tour guide, as far as schedule, itinerary, and self-behaviour are concerned. The participant will be supportive regarding the other participants, in case of mechanical problems or any other type of incident. The participant will remain with the group during the entire trip. Once at the hotel, the participant will not be obliged to join the group.

The participant agrees to be respectful of speed limits and security regulations established by the host country. He/she will be a 100% responsible for his/her rented bike or vehicle and will not place in danger, from his/her behaviour, the rest of the group.

The rental company will take an electronic print of the participant's credit card as a guarantee in the case of damage or theft. Each participant is responsible for the bike he/she has rented. There is a \$1,000 deductible excess in the case of damages and a \$2,500 deductible excess in the case of theft. Please read the information on rental vehicle collision damage and theft excess cover in your insurance brochure. The rental company will loan the participant two padlocks and a safety chain (for two bikes). The participant must use them each time the tour guide specifies.

Generally, the participant will display a respectful behaviour with the other participants and guide and will respect social behaviours (no aggressiveness, mutual support, accepting everyone as part of the group, whatever their beliefs, religion, culture, nationality or profession). The participant will need to show a certain sense of humour and will contribute, through his positive attitude, to the general accord of the group. The participant will make the commitment to accept any decision the tour guide may make in case of conflict. The tour guides are professional and experienced.

NEW PROCEDURES FOR AUSTRALIANS TRAVELLING TO THE US

From this Monday (12 January) Australians travelling to the United States of America will be required to follow new border entry procedures.

All Australian passport-holders eligible to travel to the US under that country's Visa Waiver Program must, before they travel, obtain approval through the US' Electronic System for Travel Authorisation (ESTA). This also applies to passport-holders from other countries participating in the Visa Waiver Program.

ESTA is an online system administered by the United States Government which determines the preliminary eligibility of visitors to travel under the Visa Waiver Program prior to boarding a carrier to the United States. ESTA has been operating on a voluntary basis since 1 August 2008 and will become compulsory on 12 January 2009.

The ESTA website is at: <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/>. Prospective travellers will be required to provide basic biographic, travel and eligibility information online in order to receive authorisation prior to their departure. There is no charge to complete the application.

Most travellers can expect to receive authorisation within a few minutes. However, travellers are advised to complete an ESTA as soon as they begin to plan their travel, and at least three days in advance, to avoid any last-minute delays. Travellers who do not have a valid ESTA on or after 12 January 2009 may be denied boarding, experience delayed processing or be denied admission at a United States port of entry. Once granted, electronic pre-clearance will be valid for up to two years and for multiple-entry visits to the United States.

It is recommended that travellers keep a print-out or record of their ESTA application number for reference, if required, at airports or seaports.

Australian passport-holders who hold a valid visa for travel to the United States are not required to obtain an ESTA.

What is the Visa Waiver Program?

The Visa Waiver Program allows eligible visitors from Australia and other participating countries to travel to the United States for business or pleasure for 90 days or less without first obtaining a visa.
